The Thomason Transportation Program provides free round-trip transportation for students, faculty and chaperones, allowing them to visit libraries, participate in library programs and events, visit the Center for the Book and more.

## Who is Eligible?

- Title I schools
- Daycare & Preschool programs serving low-income families
- Organizations serving children with special needs

## How to Apply

- Contact your library of choice to arrange your visit at least 4 weeks in advance. A list of all libraries can be found at [www.cabq.gov/library](http://www.cabq.gov/library).
- Download the application from the library's website or call 768-5103 to have one mailed or faxed to you.
- Fill out and submit the application at least 3 weeks in advance.
- Once your application is approved you will receive confirmation.
